**Permanent Diaconate** -The diaconate is open to married and single men alike: married men must be at least 35 years on applying; celibate men can be accepted at 25. The upper age limit is 63 at ordination. The preparation takes four years. It consists of an introductory year aimed at helping a candidate discern if he has a vocation and a three-year study programme which is approved by the Pontifical University of Maynooth. Candidates for the diaconate will obviously need to be carefully chosen.
