Parish Assembly The outgoing Parish Assembly invites all parishioners to participate in thenomination process for our new Assembly for 2019-2022. The Assembly tries to identify the needs of our people today and to find creative ways to move forward in faith by building an open and welcoming community in our Parish. In brief, we work to make Jesus known and loved and, together, the members seek to create an open, caring, compassionate faith community, involving everyone and known by its actions.

The Assembly's activities in 2016-2019 included organising three parish retreats in Scala and the grandparents masses in October. Each November saw the remembrance trees in both churches and the bereavement mass. December was always a very busy month including the ever successful Christmas concert. Januarys each year saw the collection of gifts for Edel house. Foreach Lent, we ran well-attended short courses on various aspects of our Catholic faith. Every May we held ice cream Sundays in St Patrick's church for Down Syndrome Ireland and presented certificates to First Communion and Confirmation children. We led the parish preparations for the World Meeting of Families in 2018 and also supported the NET Ministries team in the activities amongst the young people of the Parish. Finally, and throughout the year, members of the assembly compose Prayers of the Faithful for all masses, arrange occasional Eucharistic adoration, make banners for the churches and maintain the Parish website and Facebook page, in addition to hosting occasional coffee mornings after weekday masses in St Columba's. Individually, these activities are perhaps small, but we hope that collectively they made a difference and helped improve parish life.
