Eco Challenge for Lent.....Give up Plastic

This season of Lent is your opportunity to make a difference and do something beneficial for the environment and climate change. One way is by reviewing your use of plastic. Cut out or reduce your use of single-use plastic such as bottles, cutlery, straws, cotton bud sticks and food containers. Alternative items are becoming more available: reusable bottles, keep cups, paper straws, bamboo or metal cutlery. Some plastic items can be placed in your recycling bin, just make sure they are clean, dry and placed loosely in the bin. If everyone in Ireland used one less plastic item and recycled one more piece of plastic every week, we could keep at least 250 million more pieces of plastic out of the ocean ! Everyone has a role to play be it large or small in helping to Green our Parish.
