SUN 1st JAN '23 - Solemmnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God.

The Blessed Virgin Mary, The Mother of God. At the Council of Ephesus (451), Mary, the mother of Jesus was proclaimed as Mother of God acknowledging the very Godhead of her Son, Jesus Christ. Today's feast invites us to lay our hopes and plans for the new year under her motherly care and patronage In 431 the Council of Ephesus decreed that Mary is 'Theotokos' (literally "God-bearer") because her son Jesus is one person, who is both God and man, divine and human. At the Second Vatican Council (1962-65) the bishops decided not to add any new title to or make any new definition about Mary - for example, as "Mediatrix of all graces", as some of the more extreme Mariologists wanted at the time. Instead they went back to the tradition which saw Mary's greatness in her act of faith, by which she became "Mother of God",
