

SUN 8th JAN '23 - FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Jesus is anointed with the aspirit and his power. He is proclaimed Messiah. He now goes about doing good, working the signs that make him known as the servant of god. He is the one who brings good news to the poor and tells of salvation. Through baptism each one of us is ordered to the life of Christ – Priest, Prophet and King – and the Father looks on us with favour.

PRAYER REFLECTION: Lord, we thank you for deep prayer experiences when we are truly one with Jesus. They always come to us as your free gift, unexpectedly, after a long time of struggle when we felt we were drowning, abandoned by all, including you. After we have been baptised in these waters of loneliness, suddenly – heaven opens and we feel at one with the universe, the sun, the moon and the stars all seem close; - your Holy Spirit descends on us, his powerful but gentle presence so vivid that it is almost in a bodily shape like a dove; - we hear a voice resonating so deeply within us we know it must come from heaven, telling us that we are not aliens in the world but princes and princesses, members of your royal family that we are beloved, and we must never allow ourselves to feel abandoned since your favour rests forever on us.
