## **FEAST DAYS WEEK**

SAT 11th FEB '23 - On 11th February 1858 OUR LADY FIRST APPEARED to 14-year-old Bernadette Soubirous. Later Bernadette, under pressure from her parish priest, asked her, "Who are you?" and heard from Our Lady's own lips, "I am the Immaculate Conception". Lourdes has since become an impressive place of pilgrimage and is visited by millions of Catholics every year. Many cures have been reported and 67 have been officially recognised. Pope John Paul II undertook three pilgrimages to Lourdes, the last one in 2004 shortly before his death to commemorate the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the definition of the doctrine of the Immaculate Conception. Pope Benedict XVI visited Lourdes commemorating the 150th anniversary of the apparitions in September 2008.

FRI 10<sup>th</sup> FEB '23 - ST. SCHOLASTICA, sister of St. Benedict, consecrated her life to God from her earliest youth. Invoked against storms and rain. She died in 543.

# **World Youth Day 2023**
