FEAST DAYS WEEK

TUE 31st JAN '23 - JOHN BOSCO, PRIEST, EDUCATOR - Born in Piedmont (Italy) in 1815; died at Turin on this day in 1888. Grew up in extreme poverty and, after ordination, devoted his whole life to educating young people, especially the poor. Founded the Salesians, men and women who continue this work with youth throughout the world. Noted, like the order's patron, Saint Francis de Sales, for his cheerfulness and trust in the providence of God. John Bosco is the patron of youth.

WED 01st FEB '23 - ST BRIGID - On the 1st of February is a celebration of the wonderful springing back of the earth from its winter sleep. It is the season when we celebrate new beginnings and new life on earth. The sod is turned. The day lengthens. Seeds are sown and sails are hoisted.

THU 02nd FEB '23 - THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD - It is forty days after Christmas. In the 1962 calendar the feast is called the "Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary" and commonly referred to as Candlemas. This is considered a "Christmas feast," even though it is not part of the Christmas season. This the last feast of the liturgical calendar that we commemorate Christ still as an infant child. The liturgy focuses on the meeting of Christ with the elderly Simeon. With Simeon we rest our hope in the Lord.
